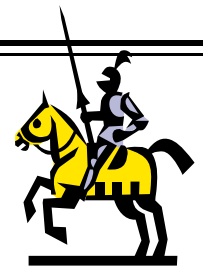

The center is in the former Our Lady of Guadalupe Church, SW 1th Street and S. Youngs Boulevard.

Staff at the center, which opened about a year ago, help women find jobs and housing. The center is supported by Catholic Charities.

Women can come in for food and financial assistance, take a shower and use a washer and dryer as they try to get a job or housing.

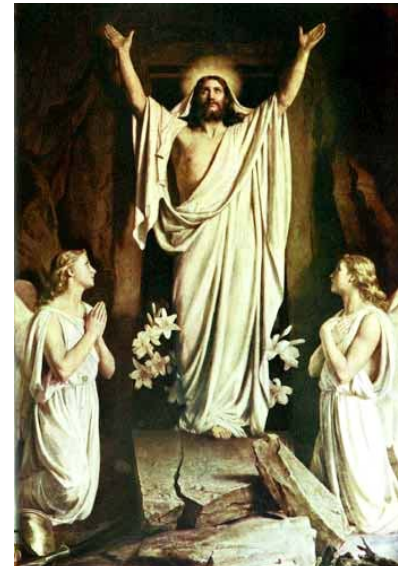
Easter juggles council schedule

Be proud that you're a Catholic.

That's the advice given recently to Catholics by Sam Miller, a Cleveland Jewish businessman.

The Catholic Church educates 2.6 million students every day at a cost to the church of \$10 billion and a savings to taxpayers of \$18 billion.

The Catholic Church has a non-profit hospital system of 637 hospitals, which account for hospital treatment of 1 out of every 5 people.

News reports would have some believe pedophilia is a major problem to the church and mostly in the Catholic Church.

But, Miller writes, 12 percent of the 300 Protestant clergy surveyed admitted to sexual intercourse with a parishioner and 38 percent acknowledged other inappropriate sexual contact in a study by the United Methodist Church. Meanwhile, 1.7 percent of the Catholic clergy has been found guilty of pedophilia; 10 percent of the Protestant ministers have been found guilty of pedophilia.

The church has been hurt by a small number of priests who likely have been weeded out by now, Miller writes. The agony that Catholics have felt and suffered is not necessarily the fault of the church.
