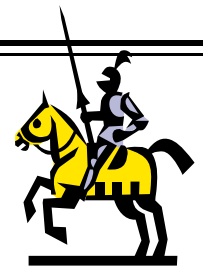

Membership in the Knights of Columbus grew from 1.7 million to 1.8 million in less than five years.
