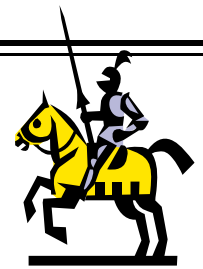

Knights to serve Lenten supper

Council 13366 will serve the Lenten meal March 26 before the Stations of the Cross.

The meal begins at 6 p.m., an hour before Stations. Volunteers should arrive at the parish hall about 5:30 p.m.

A sign-up sheet will be circulated during the March 7 meeting.

Council 13366 again is being asked to help with parking lot duties during the Stations of the Cross and meals, held each Friday evening during Lent.

The money will be donated during the Knights of Columbus state convention in April in Stillwater.

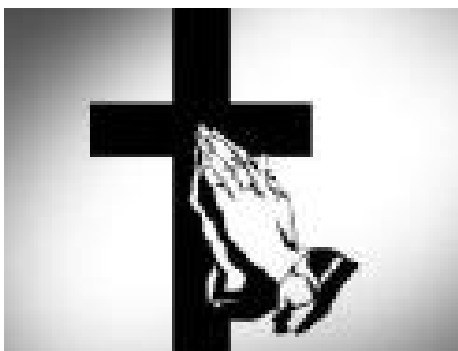


Mark your calendars

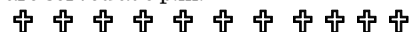


My Corner

How is your Lent going? Hard to believe Easter is about a month away, April 4.

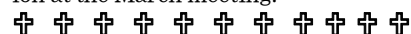
