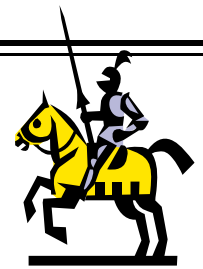

New missal to be used soon

The Roman Missal, Third Edition, the ritual text containing prayers and instructions for the celebration of the Mass, will start being used in churches later this month.

It will be used beginning the first Sunday of Advent, Nov. 27.

Pope John Paul II announced a revised version of the missal during the Jubilee Year 2000. Among other things, the revised edition of the missal contains prayers for the observances of recently canonized saints, additional prefaces for the Eucharistic prayers, additional votive Masses and Masses as well as prayers for various needs and occasions. Some updated and revised rubrics (instructions) for the celebration of the Mass also are contained in the missal.

The English translation of the missal will also include updated translations of existing prayers, including some of the well-known responses and acclamations of the people.

Musicians and parishioners alike should soon be learning the various new and revised musical settings of the Order of Mass.
