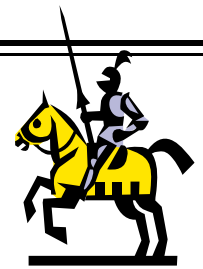

Knights again defend pledge

The Knights of Columbus continued its bi-coastal legal defense of the words "under God" in the pledge of allegiance during oral arguments Sept. 9 before the 1st U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals in Boston.

Brother Knight Kevin Hasson, president of The Becket Fund for Religious Liberty, a public interest law firm in Washington, once again represented the Order in oral arguments before an appellate court panel, as he had in San Francisco in November 2007 before a panel of the 9th Circuit. The Knights of Columbus won the California case in March.

In each case, the Knights of Columbus asked the court to become a "defendant intervener," allowing the Order to participate directly as a party to the case, rather than simply filing a "friend of the court" brief.
